Mother Hubbard's Cupboard (MHC); 315 Red Cross Street We work at MHC the 3rd & 5th Mondays of the month. **We work next at the Cupboard Monday, November 19th at 12:30pm. Come join us!** If you have any questions, contact Nancy McKean at 686-0227.

Reconciliation Against Hunger (RAH!) is part of our ministry to our community. All items collected will be taken to Mother Hubbard's Cupboard. Our **RAH** items for **November** will concentrate on holiday meal foods -- cranberry sauce (whole or jellied), canned or jar gravy, stuffing mixes, packaged mashed potatoes, canned yams and canned diced potatoes. In addition, the Cupboard is low on all items. Please remember MHC as you grocery shop -- especially if you notice a good sale on items we can use to stock MHC's shelves. *MHC requests canned goods be in small sizes, as the large family size are difficult for their clients to carry and too large for the homeless. We can always use paper bags with handles.* Thank you!!

It's time to start thinking Christmas! Poinsettias will decorate our Sanctuary on Christmas Eve, and may be taken home after the 8:00pm service. Poinsettias are \$12.00 each. Order envelopes are on the table in the narthex. The last day to order is Sunday, November 25th.
